- Assist in the day to day operations of the plant in accordance with the site licence and contractual conditions.
- Push incoming materials into allocated areas on the Sorting
- Safely and competently operate mobile plant.
- Loading vehicles/Skips with material
- Maintain the highest cleanliness of all working areas.
- Ensure any defects affecting the safe working order of a machine are reported immediately.
